What does redemption mean?

Read: John 3:16, Isaiah 6:8, Luke 19:1-10, Ezekiel 3:17–19, John 20:21-22

A Church that reaches its Full Redemptive Potential is active and moving through the place God has called her.

So where are all the people who need Jesus in Lebanon?(Literally everywhere!)

Talk about the S.E.N.T. acrostic, what do these things mean to you? How does this help you as you pursue your mission?

Special - God knows you, has called you, and now He sends you

Equipped - He doesn't send you clueless, He gives the Holy Spirit, and you have a testimony, you have all you need.

Never Alone - The Gift of the Holy Spirit and the Promise of His presence never expire, we just have to listen, pray, trust, and obey.

Time - Jesus didn't day take a week, or a few years, He sent them right then!

Zacchaeus was a tough case. His power, wealth, and unscrupulous behavior helped people keep a distance. What are the things that tend to keep us from trying to reach people for Jesus?

Read: John 13:35

How does our love for each other take down the barriers that keep people from Jesus?

For years churches held the Believe - Behave - Belong model of church, what is the danger in this?

We follow a Belong - Believe - Behave - where do we have to be careful with this?

How does Love First deal with personal sin?

How does Love First soften hearts, both for the saint and the sinner?

What kind of impact do you think Jesus's calling out to Zacchaeus by name and going to his house had on his decision to follow Christ? Why are real relationships so important?

In v7 we read about people grumbling about Jesus going to spend time with Zacchaeus. Does the church still have grumblers today?

What is the proper way to deal with an issue you see happening in the church?
