



## LP at the Movies - Best Supporting Role

We often feel like we need to do things on our own which often ends up getting us in trouble. Have you felt overwhelmed and had someone come in and give the support you needed? Can you share about that experience?

Read: Exodus 17:8-13, Deuteronomy 25:17-18

Joshua's greatness as a leader was built on a foundation of faithful obedience. What would have happened if even one of the men mentioned in the story had refused to play their part?

One reason that they had victory at the end of the day is that they had the heart of their leader in mind. Knowing that God chooses to use fallible people to do his work, how do you know if they are worthy of following?

When you think about how the Amalekites attacked the Israelites, what can we learn about how spiritual attacks are leveled at us?

What are the signs we need to look for to help us know when we need to step in and help someone?

Read: Philippians 2:1-11, Ephesians 2:10

What is the connection between how we are called to treat each other and the example of Christ on the Cross?

Paul says in Ephesians that God created us with good things He has planned for us to do. What is one thing you feel God has created you to do? Are you doing it? Why or why not?

When you are following the command of the Lord, your own agenda has to take the backseat. What gets in our way when we try to follow God?

What can we do about it?

Take time to pray for each other and our church that we might play the role God has called us all to play.
