



## **Between the Lines - Under Center**

We are called to live life between the lines. So what lines were you tempted to cross this week?

God's higher purpose is always our greatest good. Have you ever had an experience that made you question this? How did that turn out?

As Believers, we have to get under center with our lives. Which looks more like a life lived under center: Living as righteously as you know how? or Quickly repenting after you fail? Is there a difference?

Read: Colossians 1 - as you read how can you tell that Paul is living under center?

When we read about the prayer Paul prays for the people (v. 9-12) where do you find yourself growing or in need of growing the most? Where are you strong?

As you read v15-23 what most impressed you about Christ?

Paul was so moved by the power of Jesus in his life that he became a servant of the Gospel. He suffered greatly (2 Corinthians 11:21-33) and took great joy in all of that. Have you ever had to suffer for Christ. even in a small degree? How? Did you take joy in it? Why or Why not?

Paul clearly states that part of keeping Christ in center for him was about telling people about Jesus. Is that true for us all?

So how can we keep Jesus in the Center?
