What is love?

Read: Genesis 22:2, Matthew 3:17, Mark 1:11, Luke 3:22, John 3:16

These are the first mentions of love in the Bible, and then in the New Testament Gospels. What does this tell us about how much God loves us?

Read: 1 John 4:7-9

Where does love come from?

Our ability to define, respond in, and act out love that is tied to our identity in Christ. How does being identified as belonging to Christ help us love?

How do we show love?

In the New Testament, love is more of a verb than a noun. It has more to do with acting than with feeling. The call to love is not so much a call to a certain state of feeling as it is to a quality of action
