How did this interaction with Jesus change this woman's life?

Can you share a hope you haven't embraced?

Do we have to have all our questions answered before we start reaching people for Jesus?

What made the Woman at the Well such an effective witness?

When you think of sharing your faith, what feelings immediately come to mind?

**“You will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you and you will be My witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria and to the ends of the earth.”
