Read: John 2:1-11

What does this passage have to teach us about prayer?

What made Mary so confident in approaching Jesus with such a request?

On a scale of 1-10, how confident are you when you pray?

Read: Hebrews 4:16, Matthew 7:7-11, John 15:7, 1 John 3:21-22

How do confidence, faith, and prayer work together?

What helps you have more confidence in prayer?

What takes your confidence away?

Take time to cover the PRAY BOLD acronym. Why is each component important to extraordinary prayer?

Praise

How does praise shape our attitude in prayer.

Repent

Repentance is about asking God to reveal any areas of our lives that we haven't given over to him yet. If we are already forgiven for our sin, why bother?

Ask

This typically dominates our prayer time. What do our asks reveal about our relationship with God?

Your Will Be Done

Why is this an important aspect of the mature Believers prayer life?

Believing

Why is faith such a crucial aspect of our prayer life?

Out loud

Read: Psalm 142:1, Acts 4:24

Why do you think that this type of prayer was encouraged?

Lived Out

What difference does it make when our daily life matches our prayer life?

Daily

Read: Matthew 7:7

How does a daily habit of prayer impact us long term?

How can we pray for each other tonight?
